

- Rear Display Stand






Inventory Tablet

Kitchen Display System

- Alternative to kitchen printers and paper tickets
- Often popular in QSR environment
- Can be combined with kitchen printers
- Touchscreen or Bumpbar
- Chef's Preference
- Efficiency





Order at the Table

- Full Station Interface
- Access table map, start a tickets, send it to the kitchen
- Pull up an existing ticket add another round of drinks
- Tablet w/ S300 & a Thermal Printer



Pay at the Table

- Meant for use with the table map
- Allows basic split check functionality
- Not ideal for tickets saved w/ name
- Tip prompt
- Drop off at table or pull checks and take payment in real time

For Larger Installations

- Dell Computer w/ Monitor & Keyboard
- Required for 5 or more devices/licenses
- Recommended for 3+ Stations
- Back Office Workstation
